Save Our Planet !

Welcome to Save Our Planet ! This is a one-act musical, suitable for upper Key Stage 1 and lower Key Stage 2 (ages 6 - 9). Younger children can also be included in your performance through the many lively songs. The show runs for approximately 30 minutes.

Save Our Planet ! explores two important themes: caring for our environment and showing respect for other cultures. Messages about recycling and reducing global emissions are gently worked into a fun and engaging storyline about the bringing together of Earth and the fictional planet of 'Zarkonia'. Planet Zarkonia is slowly dying and the Zarkonians suspect it has something to do with the 'dirty gases' rising up from Earth. Big Zed, the bumbling Zarkonian leader, appoints Zak to travel down to Earth to help sort out the problem. Zak speedily arrives in the back garden of Mollie and Michael - two sympathetic 'Earthlings', who seem keen to help. Thanks to Earth's email and television technology, Mollie, Michael and Zak are soon appearing on 'World News' to publicise their important cause. After a few weeks their campaign has been successful and the doomed fate of Zarkonia is reversed. Big Zed rewards Mollie and Michael with medals and appoints them as interplanetary pollution monitors !

Characters: Any number of pupils can perform **Save Our Planet !** Numbers of supporting alien beings, cats, dogs, flowers, fruit and vegetables are not restricted. There are good opportunities for whole-group singing and two significant solo singing roles (Big Zed and Zak). Opportunities for smaller-group singing (duets/trios) can easily be created from verses in the songs. There are plenty of speaking parts and the *Narrator* speeches can be divided between any number of children. Non-speaking parts (especially for younger pupils) can easily be created by featuring supporting groups of alien animals and plants. A full list of speaking parts appears overleaf.

Staging, costumes & scenery: **Save Our Planet !** can be very simply staged with all the performers seated on benches, either side of a raised stage or flat floor area. Costumes, at their simplest, could be limited to plain t-shirts, colour coordinated between the different groups of aliens. Additionally, painted faces are an effective way to portray the aliens, or simple masks which still allow children to sing clearly. The *Narrators* could wear their own coordinated t-shirts, or perhaps be dressed in their own space suits ! It is important that the main Zarkonian speakers have a changeable 'third eye' which forms a part of the storyline. At the start of the story this third eye appears dull and gloomy; at the end it is 'bright and glowing'.

This can either be done by sticking each to the forehead, or by using an acetate (or clear plastic) ring which can turn freely around the head - on which each eye is painted, and twisted to the front as required. The only significant prop is the 'space pod'. At its simplest, this could be a decorated hula-hoop which fits around its passengers, or perhaps a more elaborate contraption (given time and expertise). Movement around the stage need only be simple and stylised, although the 'Alien Dance' could be more choreographed, making full use of the stage and auditorium. A colourful collage could be used as a fixed backdrop to the performance area, depicting stars, comets and planets. Alternatively, technology could be used to project suitable images onto a screen at the back of the stage.

News Reader

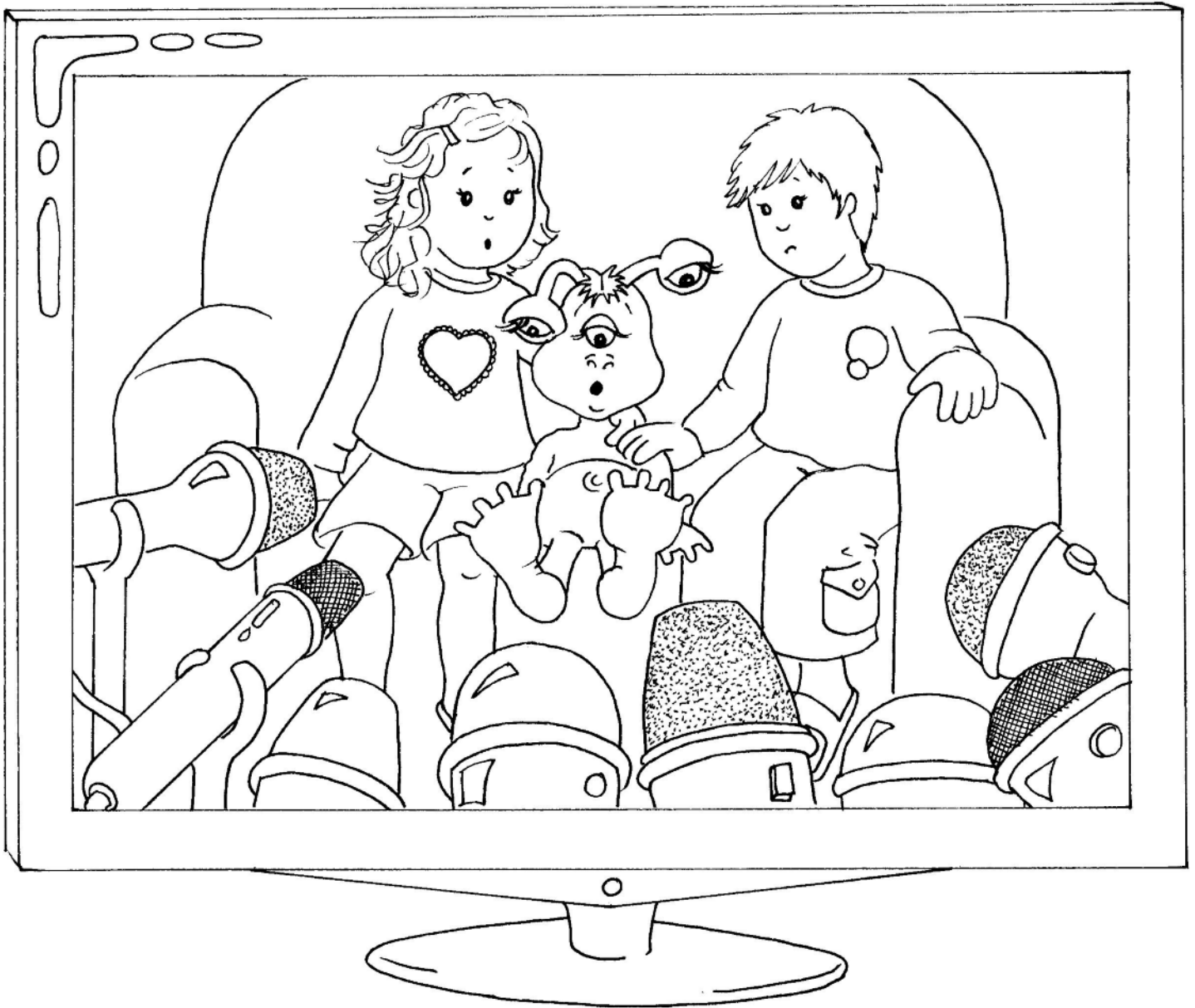
This is a most serious situation. What can the world do to save our planet and Zarkonia ?
